Title:	COVID 19 Resident and Visitor Requirements

**Policy Statement:** Adhering to the most current up to date Ministerial Orders and Government of Alberta Directives as they pertain to the COVID-19 pandemic.

**Purpose:** To outline requirements for Foundation staff, residents, families, friends, and support persons of those residents who live within the facilities. The intent is to protect the health and safety of residents and staff in these facilities while ensuring safe and meaningful connection with the persons that support them

### Principals:

3.25.01 Visiting hours shall be 9am to 7pm, seven days per week

#### 3.25.01 Indoor Visits

- All indoor visits must be booked in advance with the Lodge manager or designated staff
- All visitors shall have their temperature taken, and fill out the visitor screening form before being allowed to proceed to the resident's room
- Up to a maximum of 2 designated persons per visit
- Visitations will be in the resident's room
- No children under the age of 18 years will be allowed for indoor visits
- No pets will be allowed for indoor visits
- Residents shall be required to wear a mask for indoor visits
- All visitors must wear masks, hand sanitize etc. following all safe visitor practices upon entering the Lodge
- Visitors will be expected to sanitize high touch areas within the resident's room prior to leaving

#### 3.25.02 Outdoor Visits

- Visits not limited to designated person/s
- Up to a maximum of 5 persons including the resident
- Children under the age of 18 years will be allowed
- Pets are allowed provided they have proper vaccinations and are approved by the Foundation
- Social distancing practices will be adhered too

- Visitors must wear masks and follow safe visitor practices
- Resident shall be required to wear a mask for outdoor visitations if social distancing cannot be adhered too

3.26.03 No overnight non-essential outings will be allowed

3.25.04 Should a resident choose to leave the Lodge/s for an off-site outing for 24 hours or more they will be required to isolate for 14 days

3.25.05 Visitors who do not strictly adhere to all the procedures within this policy may have their visitor privileges revoked

3.25.06 It is the Foundations ability to assess the risk tolerance for each Lodge and amend this policy as needed.
